The Requirement

Engineer, Gavin McComb, required a mixing system for a tour of churches in the United Kingdom to promote new solo material by Supergrass frontman, Gaz Coombes.

Due to the nature of the venues McComb needed a compact system that could fit into venues that were never designed to accommodate a mixer, and he also needed to be able to run Monitors from the FOH mixer.

The Solution

Having toured with iLive systems extensively in the past, McComb selected an iLive modular system comprising a compact iLive-80 Control Surface and iDR10 MixRack to manage FOH, with iLive apps and PL controllers for additional remote control.

To resolve the challenge of looking after the band's monitors from FOH, McComb provided the three musicians with ME-1 personal mixers, networked via an ME-U hub. Although they had not encountered the ME system previously, both engineer and musicians very quickly became comfortable with it, allowing McComb to focus on the FOH mix.
